- Hosted a STEM program at the CAR Management Briefing Seminars in Traverse City for attendees' children in 2016 and 2017.
- Launched a partnership with Junior Achievement of Southeast Michigan to deliver STEM programming to an estimated 3,000 Detroit public school students annually.
- Supported the Company's facilities participating in Manufacturing Day, an annual event produced by the National Association of Manufacturers, The Manufacturing Institute, Fabricators and Manufacturers Association International and Manufacturing Extension Partnership, during which companies showcase modern manufacturing and foster interest in manufacturing careers.
- Joined Kettering University Alumni to raise donations to sponsor high school students from underserved areas, including Detroit, Jamaica and Mexico, to attend a Kettering pre-college summer program.
